NEW! Closed Tray Impression Plastic Snap-On with Abutment


The closed tray impression plastic snap-on with abutment is indicated for an implant level impression using a closed tray technique. The Plastic Snap-on enables fast and simple impression taking using the closed tray technique while getting the maximum percision of the open tray technique.

Steps to take the impression with the plastic snap-on:

- The abutment is inserted directly into the implant, and secured with its screw.
- The plastic impression snap-on is placed over the abutment and snapped into place.
- The plastic impression snap-on will be picked up in the impression.
- The abutment is removed from the implant.
- The laboratory will connect an implant analog to the abutment and then snap the abutment into the impression snap-on in the impression.
- The laboratory will now pour the master model




Please notice the correct way to insert the abutment


